

CHANGES IN AOSA RULES FOR TESTING SEEDS  
EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 1, 1970

A considerable number of changes in and additions to the Rules for Testing Seeds were adopted by the Association of Official Seed Analysts at the 1970 meeting of the Association in Jefferson City, Missouri. These changes become effective October 1, 1970.

A complete revised edition of the Rules will soon be published by the Association in a loose-leaf format. In the new addition, the purity and germination tables will be printed in two forms:

- (a) Species listed alphabetically by scientific name  
(common names listed secondarily).
- (b) Species listed alphabetically by common name  
(scientific names listed secondarily).

The changes which were adopted are reported here so they may be put in use on the effective date.
