Proposals for Rules Changes

(These proposals were distributed in a loose form with the February 1976 Newsletter)

These proposals will be discussed and voted on at the AOSA meeting in Hershey, PA. Please study each proposal carefully and send your comments to the committee chairman.

Revision of "Rules" sections
2.6, 2.7, 2.9, 2.10, 2.11, 2.12, 3.1 and 4.8

2.6 Seed unit. - The seed unit is the structure usually regarded as a seed in planting practices and in commercial channels. The seed unit may consist of one or more of the following structures:

- a. True seeds.
- b. Seed units in the grass family:
 - (1) Caryopses and florets;
 - (2) Multiple florets and spikelets in tall oatgrass (Arrhenatherum elatius), oat (Avena), grammas (Bouteloua), rhodesgrass (Chloris gayana), barley (Hordeum) and bluegrass (Poa);
